Listen to your child read every day

Children bring home a Read Write Inc. Storybook each week once they have worked on it in school. They should be very familiar with this book and be able to read it to you quite confidently. Choose a quiet time when they are wide awake.

Help your child to:

- read the sounds and words at the front of the book, before they read the story
- sound out any new words as they read the story.

Read back each page to them, after they have read it.

If the child has enjoyed the story, encourage them to read it again on the next day to increase their fluency.

Most importantly...do it all with patience and love.
