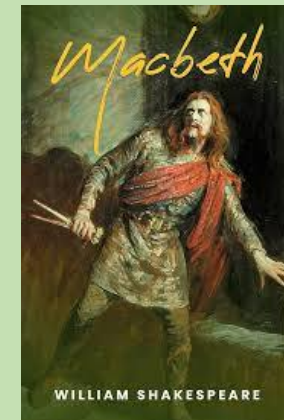
## Science
